COMMISSION MEETINGS AND REPORTS

REASONS FOR PURCHASING SCRIP

Parishioner Jim Oates made a presentation for Scrip last Sunday, by giving reasons to purchase SCRIP. Some of his reasons:
 • You are giving St. Ann's a donation without spending extra money.
 • You spend the same amount at the retailer that you paid for the card.
 • It is safe to use. There have been a few problems with cards, but Shop With Scrip will replace your card or the full value of the card if there is an issue.
 • The government wants you to buy SCRIP, they give you a deduction for your taxes on the rebates paid to St. Ann's.
 • No chance of having our account hacked, because you are paying with a "gift" card, not your debit card.
 One item that Jim did not mention: look around the stores you frequent. Do you see the racks of gift cards for sale from many retailers? Did you ever wonder who gets the rebate from that sale? It is NOT the charity of your choice (St. Ann's). The big box retailers are getting the rebate you could be giving to OUR church. SO Think about purchasing Scrip from St. Ann's, the church you worship at each Sunday. REMINDER: NO SALES NEXT WEEKEND-IT'S PANCAKE BREAKFAST TIME!
