Parish Sacramental Policies

Baptism - Those requesting Baptism (for their children) must be registered and attending the Parish for mass at least six months prior to the request. There is a formation meeting before a date can be scheduled for the Baptism.

GodParents/Sponsors - In order to serve in either of these roles one must be a practicing Catholic who has been Confirmed and if married, your marriage must have taken place before a Catholic Priest (or deacon). A Practicing Catholic is one who is registered in the Parish and attends Mass on a regular basis.

Wedding - Couples requesting a Wedding must be registered and practicing their Faith by attending Mass for at least a year before a date can be reserved. There are Pre-Cana classes as well as several appointments with the Pastor that are required. Please contact the Parish a year in advance.

Volunteers Needed

One of the things that makes St. Ann's a wonderful place to worship is the willingness of those that attend St. Ann's to volunteer when needed. We are in great need of additional Lector/Commentators, Greeters and especially Eucharistic Ministers. If you do not have this confirmation, you cannot be admitted to Mass. A facemask is required.
